INTENSIVE PHASE VS MAINTENANCE PHASE OF SWELLING

Intensive treatment involves the use of specialized compression aids with the goals of reducing swelling and limb size. Intense means strong, powerful or forceful.

Maintenance implies a status quo or steady state. It means upkeep, care, conservation or preservation. When applied to swelling, no increases or decreases in limb size are occurring.

During the intensive phase, compression is altered from the usual maintenance garment, designed to force fluid out of the tissues and can last as long as 3-4 weeks depending on the situation. Maintenance garments are usually arm sleeves or leg stockings. Some require a Velcro garment for ease of application.

Intensive treatment may be required:

- When beginning treatment for swelling
- When swelling becomes unmanageable after a period of maintenance
- After a bout with cellulitis that has caused increased swelling

Intensive phase may also be done prior to ordering a new compression garment to see if there is any extra fluid that may be removed. I personally recommend doing this once a year if possible. Specifically in the fall after a hot summer that may have caused some fluid accumulation.

COMPRESSION DURING THE INTENSIVE PHASE

Bandages can be washed in a garment bag in the laundry and laid flat to dry. Do not use fabric softener or put in the dryer.

Last for about a month of daily bandaging.

COMPRESSION OPTIONS

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- A Two layer system that is put on by a lymphedema therapist.
- Left on for 2-5 days and reapplied
- Less bulky
- Better mobility
- Foot wear more easily applied

Arm \$36.00+tx each change

Full leg \$ 70.00 each change

Half leg \$36.00 each change

Some insurance companies will cover cost of bandaging, Check with provider.

Typically you would come in and have a treatment with your lymphedema therapist and then have the Coban 2 bandages applied. In 2-5 days you would return and have the bandages re-applied.

Note: In Waterloo-Wellington area, the LIHN nurses will wrap lower leg if you also have a wound A physician referral is needed and you will be required to go for arterial testing to verify circulation status.
